Only those who have been commissioned may take the Blessed Sacrament from church and transport it away from the Cathedral.

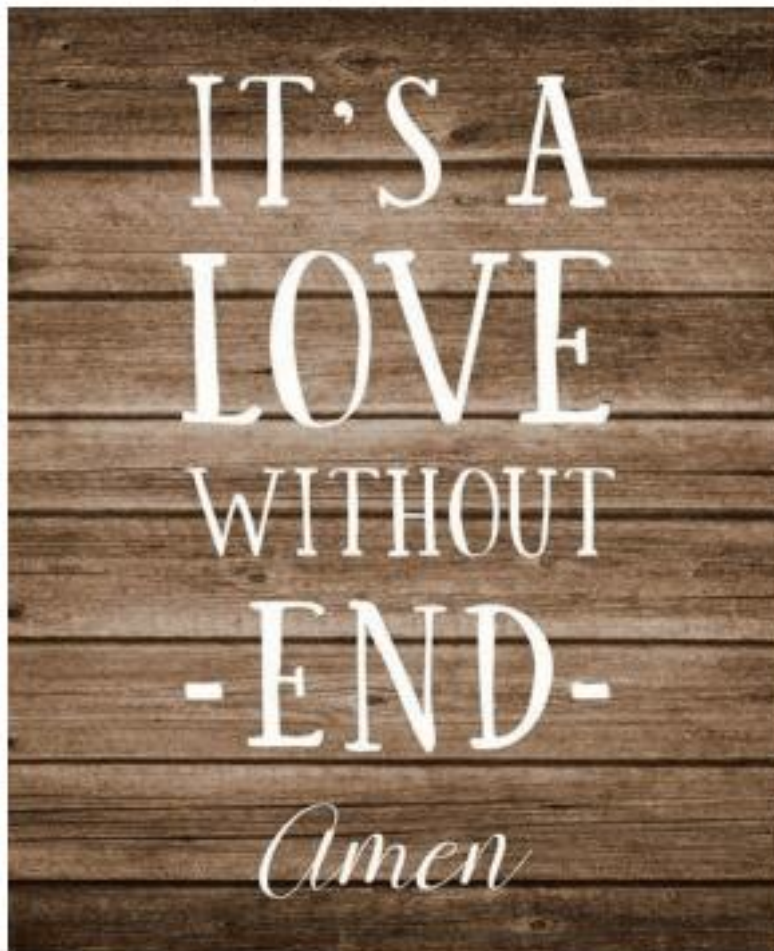
